

Statement of Circumstances for Exclusive and Non-Exclusive Milk Supply Agreements

Freedom Foods Group (FFG) has entered into sufficient milk supply agreements to meet its current and forecast demand for milk between 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022 (FY22).

The following points outline the circumstances in which FFG would enter into the standard form milk supply agreements published on its website:

- The farm must hold a current food safety licence or accreditation from the relevant State regulatory authority.
- FFG's preference are farms that are located within 250km of FFG's Shepparton site at 1/102 Old Dookie Road, Shepparton, Victoria.
- The collection point must be accessible for milk to be collected by a 19-meter B-Double tanker at a minimum.
- The farm business must be of commercial scale delivering a consistent supply of milk across the season using industry-agreed best practice production methods.
- The farm must provide evidence that their milk supply in the previous 12-month period has been of consistently high quality.
- The farm must be willing to be a partner to FFG's business, including hosting visits from third parties including FFG's personnel, investors and customers on reasonably short notice.
